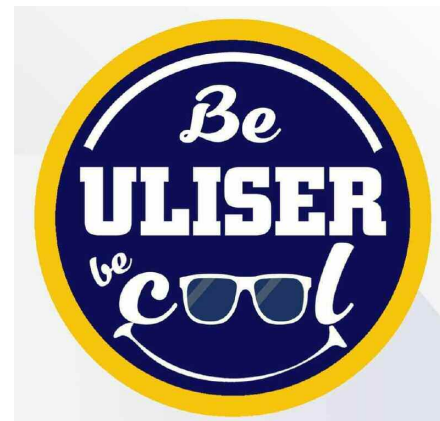

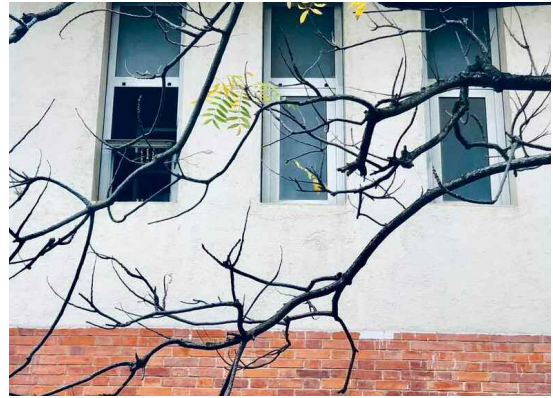


THE RATE OF EMPLOYED STUDENTS UPON GRADUATION: 92,5 %

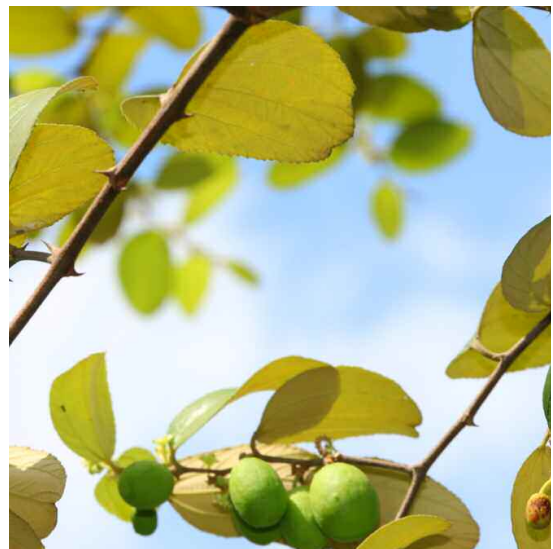

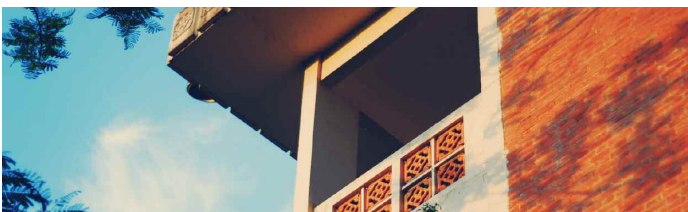

ONE ASIA CONVENTION HANOI 2018 SUCCESSFULLY ORGANIZED

On August 3rd and 4th, 2018, the International Convention One Asia 2018 took place at Lotte Hotel, Hanoi under the theme “One Asia Convention Hanoi 2018 – Hope for the Future”. The Convention was co-hosted by One Asia Foundation (OAF) and ULIS – VNU with the participation of over 600 delegates from 31 countries in Asia and other continents. The Convention was a forum for politicians, managers and scholars to share their knowledge, ideas, experience and effective solutions in order to create an Asian community in the upcoming time. The Convention covered a wide range of topics such as the foundation of an Asian Community, politics, economy, environment, society, history, education, philosophy, religion, literature, chemistry, art, communication and other related issues.



PROJECT ON RENOVATION OF PRACTICE, INTERNSHIP, AND DEVELOPMENT OF SUPPLEMENTARY SKILLS FOR STUDENTS IN THE PERIOD OF 2018-2020 ISSUED AND IMPLEMENTED

The Project on renovation of practice, internship, and development of supplementary skills for students of ULIS-VNU in the period 2018-2020 (also known as The Learning by Doing Project) was dated June 1st, 2018.

The goal of the project is to renovate practice, internship, and develop complementary skills for students through the development of an internship record. The University expects the internship record will be a motivation to boost student’s dynamics, proactiveness and responsibility so as to increase job opportunities for themselves upon graduation. The Project ‘Learning by Doing’ includes 5 important key contents (or keywords): "Learning in combination with practice", "Internship record", "Practice", "Internship" and "Soft skills".



3 FAST-TRACK PROGRAMS ACCORDING TO CIRCULAR NO 23/2014/TT-BGDĐT IN JAPANESE, KOREAN AND CHINESE LANGUAGES SUCCESSFULLY RECRUITED

In the 2018-2019 academic year, ULIS-VNU had 1,500 students admitted and enrolled in 18 different courses, of which 132 students admitted to international partnership programs and 312 students admitted to double-degree programs. At the high school level, FLSS welcomed 833 new students. At the graduate level, the University recruited 141 Master's students and 10 doctoral students.

Particularly, the University has successfully recruited 322 students for its fast-track programs according to Circular No 23/2014/TT-BGDĐT in Chinese, Korean and Japanese languages. Even though these programs have been newly implemented this year, it draws great attention from many candidates and parents. The University expects these programs will meet social demands in terms of high quality human resources. The programs are committed to offer high quality curricular, standard outcomes, exceptional facilities, special policies and so on. After the first semester, the programs received a lot of positive feedbacks.

3 FAST-TRACK PROGRAMS ACCORDING TO CIRCULAR No 23/2014/TT-BGDĐT IN ENGLISH, FRENCH AND GERMAN LANGUAGES DEVELOPED

In 2018, after the successful recruitment of the Fast-track programs in Chinese, Korean and Japanese languages, the University developed 3 new fast-track programs according to Circular No 23/2014 /TT-BGDĐT in English, French and German languages. These programs will be implemented in 2019.



FACILITIES AND EQUIPMENT STRENGTHENED AND UPGRADED

In 2018, ULIS-VNU continued to implement the task of strengthening and upgrading facilities, equipment for training, scientific research, and development & cooperation, including the renovation and addition of 10 lecture rooms in Blocks B2 and C2; installation of an air conditioning system and projectors for all lecture rooms (192 rooms in total); installation of a camera system in Block A2; installation of a ULIS-Wifi system in the campus; opening of a self-study space for students, etc.

PRODUCTS OF THE MAJOR NATIONAL LEVEL RESEARCH PROJECT - PART OF THE NORTHWEST PROGRAM TIMELY COMPLETED

The project on "Research on developing a model to improve English and Chinese competences for Customs, Foreign Relations, Tourism officials and Border Guards to implement public services in the Trend of International Integration of the Northwest region" (also known as Northwest Project) - part of the Northwest Program, is the largest State-level project so far that the University has successfully bid. The Project was approved by VNU President, and signed on October 30th, 2017. The University believes that the Project will offer a lot of ground breaking ideas in terms of efficiency in developing models to improve English and Chinese competencies. Those ideas are expected to suit practical conditions, and meet the needs of Customs, Foreign Relations, Tourism and Border Guards to perform their public services.

After a year of implementation, the project has completed all the tasks and objectives with high applicability. A total of 35 products including 14 programs and 21 documents were designed and compiled by the University.



STANDARDS OF CAPACITY AND QUALITY OF FLSS STUDENTS ISSUED AND APPLIED IN TEACHING AND LEARNING

On December 29th, 2017, President Do Tuan Minh signed Decision No. 2728/QĐ-ĐHNN promulgating the standards of capacity and quality of FLSS student (also known as the Portrait of FLSS students). The standards of capacity and quality of FLSS students set necessary quality requirements for students and regulate general principles and orientations for the school's educational activities, including teaching, supplementary and extracurricular ones. Accordingly, a student must have 10 capacities and 7 qualities.

The 10 capacities comprise self-understanding, self-control and self-study; communication, cooperation and leadership; problem solving, activeness and creativity; language; calculus; understanding of nature and society; technology; information technology; good aesthetics; and physical well-being.

The 7 qualities include patriotism, compassion, honesty, responsibility, self-esteem, diligence and discipline.

The standards of capacity and quality have been applied to teaching, learning and training activities at FLSS with numerous positive feedbacks.





3 NATIONAL ENGLISH OLYMPIADS FOR SPECIALIZED HIGH SCHOOLS' STUDENTS, STUDENTS WHO MAJOR AND DO NOT MAJOR IN ENGLISH IN COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES NATIONWIDE ORGANIZED

In 2018, ULIS - VNU successfully organized 3 National English Olympiads: English Olympiad for Non-English Major Students on December 9th; English Olympiad for English Major Students on November 30th; National English Speaking Contest on November 2nd. In previous years, the University had organized a number of similar competitions but this is the first time it was assigned by the National Foreign Language Project of the Ministry of Education and Training to organize the all three major competitions.

ULIS WAS ASSIGNED TO ORGANIZE FOSTERING CLASSES IN FOREIGN LANGUAGE ASSESSMENT FOR SPECIALIZED OFFICIALS, AND APPROVED TO IMPLEMENT THE PROJECT ON HOLDING FOREIGN LANGUAGE EXAMINATIONS ACCORDING TO THE 6-LEVEL FRAMEWORK OF FOREIGN LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY ASSESSMENT IN VIETNAM

In 2018, ULIS - VNU was assigned by the Ministry of Education and Training to organize fostering classes in foreign language assessment for specialized officials according to the Decision No. 2140/ BGDĐT-QLCL dated May 25th, 2018 by the Minister of Education and Training. In order to implement this Decision, the University has organized a number of fostering classes for lecturers of many universities such as Hanoi National University of Education, Hanoi University, Thai Nguyen University, Northwest University, Hanoi Metropolitan University, Hong Duc University, Vinh University, Hai Phong University, etc.

After that, the project on holding foreign language proficiency examinations according to the 6-level framework of foreign language proficiency in Vietnam was also approved by MoET. Accordingly, the University officially becomes an organizer of foreign language proficiency examinations in Vietnam.



60TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE FACULTY OF ENGLISH AND 40TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE FACULTY OF LANGUAGE EDUCATION AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZED

On November 18th, 2018, ULIS-VNU solemnly celebrated the 60th anniversary of the establishment of the Faculty of English (1958 – 2018) and the 40th anniversary of the establishment of the Faculty of Language Education & Professional Development (formerly known as Faculty for In-service Training) under the theme “Follow previous generations’ footsteps”. These two Faculties have long-standing histories, and great contributions to the University's foreign language training activities. The celebrations are opportunities for teachers, students and alumni to reflect upon the journeys of development, and to return home.

ASSOC. PROF. DR. LAM QUANG DONG WAS APPOINTED A VICE PRESIDENT OF ULIS



On August 8th, 2018, at the closing ceremony of the 2017-2018 school year, VNU President Nguyen Kim Son announced Decision No. 1868/QĐ-ĐHQGHN dated June 6th, 2018 on appointing Assoc. Prof. Dr. Lam Quang Dong to be one of the Vice Presidents of ULIS. Accordingly, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Lam Quang Dong officially assumed the post of ULIS Vice President from June 15th, 2018.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Lam Quang Dong is the former Head of the Science and Technology Office. He currently serves as the Editor-in-Chief of *VNU Journal of Foreign Studies*.

Assoc. Prof. Dr. Lam Quang Dong has been teaching English to undergraduates since 1989.

He graduated with a Master's Degree in Teaching English to Speakers of Other languages (TESOL) at Boston University, USA in 1995. He successfully defended the Doctoral dissertation in Linguistics at the University of Social Sciences and Humanities, VNU in 2007, and was awarded the academic title of Associate Professor in 2013.

ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

Spanish and Italian classes launched: in the 2018-2019 school year, the University officially put Spanish and Italian into its teaching curriculum as second languages before these can become majors, and new departments can be established at ULIS. For this purpose, the University has launched language classes for lecturers and staff.



The first cohort of the Master's course in German language partnership program opened: on May 7th, 2018, the opening ceremony of the first cohort of the Master's course in 'German language' and 'German as a second foreign language in the context of Vietnam-Germany relationship' took place. The program was approved on June 1st, 2017 and funded by the European Union (Erasmus+ program) and the German Academic Exchange Agency (DAAD).

Students of the courses will then be granted certificates by both ULIS and Leipzig University (Germany). Every year, 10 students will be enrolled, including 5 students from each university. The first cohort has 2 German and 5 Vietnamese students enrolled.

The first Korean Language Master's course in Vietnam launched: on October 24th, 2018, within the framework of the International Conference on "New advances in teaching Korean language and culture in Vietnam", ULIS, the Korea International Exchange Foundation and the Korean Scientific Research Association in Vietnam co-hosted the opening ceremony of the first Master's course in Korean Language at the University. In 2018, ULIS-VNU enrolled 13 students in total after two rounds of intake.

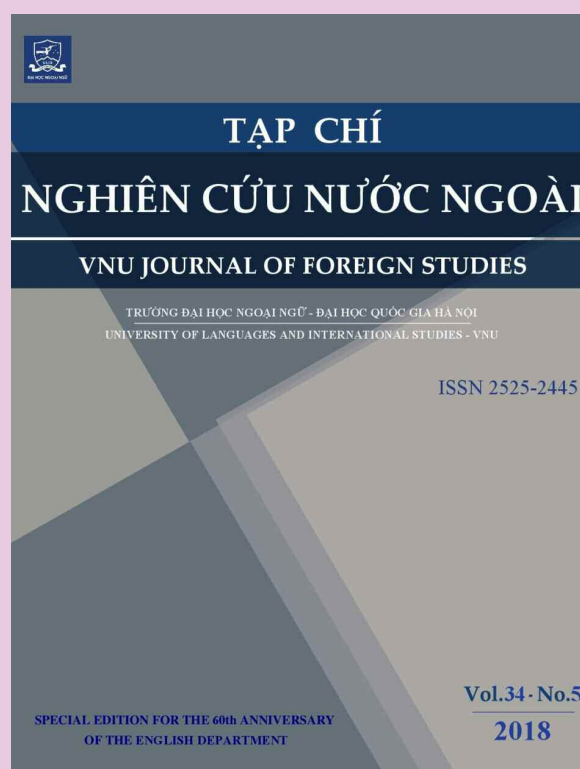


SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

Scientific conferences held: in 2018, ULIS continued to strengthen scientific and technological activities such as organization and co-organization of a number of conferences and seminars: National Scientific Conference 2018 on 'Studying and Teaching languages and international studies in Vietnam'; International Conference on 'Teaching and Learning foreign languages associated with subject-matter content in the Context of International Integration - Theory and Practice'; International Conference on 'New advances in teaching Korean language and culture in Vietnam'; International Graduate Research Symposium for Master's students and PhD students; the 3rd International Science Conference on 'Teaching Chinese Language in Chinese Cultural area'; International Conference on 'Cooperation in East Asia and Human Resource Development'; Seminar on 'Using Textbooks in Teaching English in Vietnam'; Seminar on 'Developing a model of research community between instructors and graduate students'; Seminar of scientists on graduate education and science & technology development; Seminar 'EdCamp Vietnam 2018'; Seminar on 'Quantitative research methods', etc.



VNU Journal of Foreign Studies published: in 2018, *VNU Journal of Foreign Studies*, an official and independent scientific publication of ULIS - VNU, was published with 6 issues (3 in Vietnamese and 3 in English, including one English issue to celebrate the 60th anniversary of the establishment of the Faculty of English).



COOPERATION & DEVELOPMENT

Signing ceremony with domestic and international partners held: in 2018, ULIS continued to cement cooperative and developmental activities with different institutions and departments within and without the country, including Tokushin Group (Japan), University of Victoria Wellington (New Zealand), College of Social Sciences and Humanities - Mohammed University V-Rabat (Morocco Kingdom), GEC Organization (Spain), IDP Education Organization (Vietnam), LG Display Vietnam Hai Phong, Global Education Group (GES), Dongduk Women's University (Korea), Bank of BIDV (Cau Giay branch), General Department of National Security and Defense of Korea, the French Embassy of Vietnam, Lang Son Department of Education and Training, Thanh Hoa Department of Education and Training, Vinh Phuc Continuing Education Center, Overseas Manpower Development Organization (Japan), etc. These activities not only expand the University's partner network but also create better conditions for students to have more opportunities to acquire international degrees, study abroad, do internship abroad, secure scholarships, etc.



ULIS, the destination of many special guests: as a foreign language school, ULIS always receives great attention from institutions, diplomatic agencies, international organizations and large corporations. In the past year, the University was privileged to welcome Ms. Marie Royce, assistant secretary of US's Foreign Affairs; Mr. Azzeddine Farhane, Moroccan Ambassador to Vietnam; Lieutenant General Lee Seok Gu, Commander-in-Chief of the General Department of National Security, Korea; Mr. Etienne Rolland-Piegue, Counselor of Cooperation and Cultural Activities/Director of French Institute in Vietnam; Mr. Salah AA Alturki, Libyan Embassy Representative; etc.

Whether they came to visit, exchange, attend a ceremony, or give a lecture, all the guests expressed their love toward ULIS.



East Asia Cooperation Center under the Cooperation & Development Office established:

on March 29th, 2018, at the International Conference on 'Cooperation in East Asia and human resource development', President Do Tuan Minh announced Decision No. 549/QĐ-ĐHNN on the establishment of East Asia Cooperation Center (CEAREC) under the Cooperation & Development Office. Dr. Bui Dinh Thang - Deputy Head of the Cooperation & Development Office was appointed Director of the Center. The Center has the function of organizing research and educational cooperation activities on languages, economics, politics, cultures, histories, country studies, and so on in the East Asia region. Since its inception, the Center has been implementing a number of activities such as organization of the international conference on 'Cooperation in Asia and developing human resources', participation in teaching the module 'Understanding Asian Community', etc.



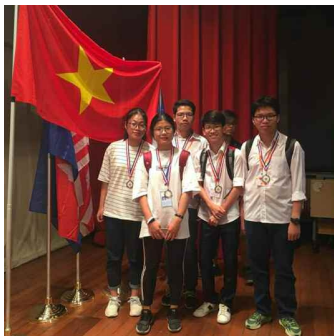
Cooperation office between VNU and FEFU opened: on December 10th, 2018, the opening ceremony of the cooperation office between VNU and Far Eastern Federal University was held at ULIS. The opening of the cooperation office is part of the cooperation agreement between VNU and FEFU. This is the basis for the development of cooperation between the two universities in areas such as in ternship, dissemination of culture, and student exchange. The office is located on the 4th floor, Block A1, ULIS. As planned, VNU will also open an office at FEFU in the near future.



STUDENTS AFFAIRS

ULIS students honored to receive a number of domestic and foreign awards:

In 2018, ULIS and FLSS students secured a number of awards such as Gold Medal at CleanEnviro Summit Singapore 2018; First Prize in French at the 2018 National Examination for Gifted Students; First Prize at TOPJ Japanese Speaking Contest 2018; First Prize for undergraduates at the 4th Hosei Japanese Speaking Contest; Prize of the Council of Cultural Ministers, Germany; the 2018 KOVA Award for potential students; Third Prize at the 1st Talented Student in Chinese language Contest in Northern area; Special Prize for individuals at the 11th "Chinese Bridge" Competition for high school students in Vietnam; First Prize at "Light Path", the Ho Chi Minh Philosophy Understanding Contest; Third Prize at Teen Talk 2018; First Prize at the 10th Russian Olympiad; Third Prize at the International Debate Contest in Japan; Runner-up at VNU Cup, First Prize at the Hanoi People Contest 2018, etc.



FLSS students yielded impressive results in foreign languages at the National High School examination:

in 2018, FLSS had 443 candidates attending the National High School examination. Although the results in foreign languages of the whole country on average decreased in comparison to the previous year, the results of FLSS students remained very high: The average English test score was 8.96 for students who majored in English and 8.65 for students who did not major in English but Russian, French, Chinese, German and Japanese. 7 FLSS students secured full scores in English out of a total of 28 students in Hanoi and 76 students nationwide. The results in Russian, French, Chinese, German and Japanese also were very positive. Japanese test score on average was 9.02, German was 9.1, Russian was 8.87, French was 8.65, and Chinese was 8.37. Particularly, a student who majored in Japanese secured a full score in Japanese.

Active participation in community services: volunteering is one of the highlights in the youth movement at ULIS. In 2018, ULIS students continued to contribute to the community through the following activities: blood donation, contribution to building roads and cleaning martyrs' cemeteries, organization of activities to pay tribute to heroic martyrs, presentation of gifts to families of preferential policies, etc. These activities strongly demonstrated the morals "Return gratitude to those who have sacrificed for their nation" and "When you eat a fruit, think of the grower who planted the tree". These also highlight the revolutionary tradition, patriotism and national pride; raise the awareness and responsibility of young generation in constructing and protecting the country; and strengthen the solidarity among brother institutions.



Support for the start-up movement: in 2018, the University boosted its support for the start-up movement through activities such as organization of skills courses, organization of seminars on start-up, provision of advice to students, and especially launch of ULIS Start-up Idea Contest 2018 with the two first prizes for 'C-trans' and 'Protect X' projects.

Support for talent-development: ULIS students are not only good at foreign languages but also very talented. In order to help them develop their talents, have a playing ground to assert themselves, and find jobs, the University organized a lot of support activities in 2018 such as presentation of scholarships of KEB HANA, Lotte, Shinnyo, Mitsubishi, Kumho Asiana, Yamada, Embassy of Qatar in Vietnam, Han Soo Kong, French-Vietnamese Friendship Association, and so on; introduction of student exchange programs with overseas education institutions; organization of internship programs in Japan; organization of Job Fair; organization of ULIS Festival of Innovation – Research – Entrepreneurship (F.I.R.E); development of the University's club network system; organization of talent competitions; etc.



Activities of international students: as a foreign language training university, ULIS is a "residence" of many international students, including students of exchange programs (ULIS and FLSS students are also exchanged from the opposite direction), full-time undergraduates, students taking part in Vietnamese language and culture short-term courses, international students studying Vietnamese to get certificates, and so on. International students can participate in a number of cultural exchange programs, anniversaries and sightseeing while studying here.



OTHER PROMINENT ACTIVITIES

Organization of the IELTS exam: on April 20th, 2018, ULIS – VNU held an official signing ceremony with IDP Vietnam Education Co., Ltd. (IELTS Representative Office) about organizing an IELTS test at ULIS. Accordingly, ULIS becomes an official partner of IDP Education Organization (co-owner of IELTS test - International English Language Testing System in Vietnam). IDP IELTS exams are held regularly and periodically at ULIS - VNU from May, 2018. In addition to the IELTS preparatory courses conducted by the University's lecturers, the two sides also agreed to organize regular training skill course and free mock tests for students and candidates who register for preparations and sit the IELTS exam of IDP at ULIS.



Trade Union activities: in 2018, the Trade Union of ULIS had positive results on all 6 areas, political and ideological work; participation in the University's administration; provision of generous care to and protection of the legitimate rights and interests of officials, staff and employees; movement activities and social activities; women's work; development of the Trade Union and the Party. The Trade Union also successfully organized anniversaries and events such as Vietnamese Women's Day, Vietnamese Teachers' Day, International Children's Day. Moreover, the Trade Union organized women's football tournament and gathered donation to support students with special circumstances, and a lot of other meaningful practical activities. Particularly, in the VNU Trade Union Music Festival 2018, ULIS won one second prize and one first prize for the best performances. What is more, ULIS secured the Championship on the VNU Trade Union Football Tournament 2018.



Organization of a number of big festivals: in 2018, ULIS organized a lot of festivals such as the Francophonie Day, Korean Cultural Festival, International Arabic Language Festival, ULIS Festival of Innovation – Research – Entrepreneurship (F.I.R.E), Job Fair, etc. In addition to the support for learning, research and employment, these festivals are opportunities for generations of lecturers, staff, students and alumni to exchange and connect with others. At the same time, these festivals popularize and promote the languages and cultures of different countries.



Key tasks in 2019

- 1. Training:** enrolling and effectively organizing training activities of the fast-track programs on English, French, German, Japanese, Korean and Chinese languages;
- 2. Science and Technology:** deployment of measures to support lecturers in scientific research and knowledge transfer; Organization of national and international scientific conferences;
- 3. Students Affairs:** renovation of practice, internship, and supplementary skill development for students of the University;
- 4. Development & Cooperation:** intensification of international cooperation in foreign language education and assessment; renovation of measures of teacher development; increase the number of international students at the University; and creation of opportunities for students to study abroad in both short-term and long-term programs;
- 5. Facilities - Equipment:** effective use of facilities and equipment so as to better major activities such as scientific research, training, and cooperation & development;
- 6. University administration:** implementation of supplementary programs for lecturers and staff of the University.

ACCOMMODATION

Consisting of 1,040 rooms in an area of 4,680 m², ULIS dormitory is the residence of students of FLSS and ULIS, international students and other students of VNU.
