I/ PROMINENT ACTIVITIES OF ULIS LEADERS

ULIS attended Eastern Economic Forum and APEC Conference on Higher Education Cooperation

On September 4th, 2021, together with delegates from VNU, ULIS attended the Eastern Economic Forum and the APEC Conference on Higher Education Cooperation through an online platform.

The Eastern Economic Forum 2021 (EEF 2021) took place on September 2nd-4th, 2021 in the campus of the Far Eastern Federal University (FEFU) in the city of Vladivostok and ended with hundreds of successful parallel working sessions.

Delivering her speech at the session “Students’ Success Orientation: Linking Universities with the Labor Market”, Vice President Ha Le Kim Anh emphasized the need for innovative thinking fostering activities for university students and lecturers. She also shared ULIS’s successful experience over the years.



At the end of EEF 2021 and the 10th APEC CCHE, the delegates were delighted with the successful results achieved in the events and many agreements on multi-sectoral cooperation were signed.

II/ COOPERATION & DEVELOPMENT

1. Opening ceremony of Korean language teacher training course in 2021 held

On July 5th, 2021, ULIS-VNU held the opening ceremony of the Korean Language Teacher Training Course in 2021 with the sponsorship of the Korean Language Center in Ho Chi Minh City, which is a representative agency of the Korean Ministry of Education in Ho Chi Minh City.



President Do Tuan Minh hoped that through this course, the participants would gain much professional knowledge and practical experience for their teaching activities, contributing to promoting the quality of Korean language training in Vietnam, especially at the upper secondary level.

On behalf of 43 learners participating in the course, Ms. Nguyen Thi Nhat Linh thanked the organizers and expressed her determination to study hard for good results.

The learners will be taught by leading professors and doctors in Korean language, Korean studies and Korean language education. The course consists of theoretical modules on teaching methods, advanced Korean practice and internship, which is expected to last from August to November, 2021. According to the planned schedule, after completing the course, the learners will be granted a certificate of teaching methods and a certificate of Korean language teaching issued by ULIS.

2. Training course on improving pedagogical capacity for English teachers in numerous provinces in the North of Vietnam in 2021 held

In July and August, 2021, ULIS-VNU, in collaboration with Departments of Education and Training of numerous provinces, held the training course to improve pedagogical capacity for English teachers.

The training course to improve pedagogical capacity for English is a series of activities to improve pedagogical capacity for nearly 1,600 English teachers from 7 provinces and centrally-run cities under the task of fostering teachers which the National Foreign Language Project has assigned to ULIS.

The training program includes such activities as theoretical exchange, practical sessions on lesson planning and teaching (micro teaching and practical fieldwork).



Delivering his speech, President Do Tuan Minh believed that after this program, the teachers would not only improve their knowledge and skills but also know how to understand each other's feelings, and have more passion for education.

3. Signing ceremony of cooperation agreement with EHLE Academy (Japan) held

On August 19th, 2021, ULIS-VNU and EHLE Academy (Japan) held a ceremony to sign a memorandum of understanding on cooperation.



At the ceremony, representatives of the two institutions signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), agreeing to cooperate and implement programs that bring practical benefits to both parties.

Delivering his speech at the ceremony, President Do Tuan Minh said that ULIS was honored to sign an MOU with and become an official partner of EHLE Academy. The President hoped that after the signing ceremony, the two sides would actively cooperate with each other to introduce ULIS students to programs at EHLE.

EHLE Academy Chairman Hasegawa Keiichi hoped that the two sides would carry out more exchange and cooperation programs to adapt to the new situation and have more effective cooperation in the future.

The MOU signing opens up many opportunities for the University's students to study and do their internship in Japan.

III/ PROMINENT ACTIVITIES OF THE UNIVERSITY

1. Training program of key trainers for the course “Design your life” in the academic year 2021-2022 organized

In July 2021, ULIS-VNU organized the training program for the lecturers of the course “Design your life”.



The training course was organized to build a key teaching team for the course “Design your life”. This is a new subject that will be taught at ULIS from the school year 2021-2022.

Delivered in 6 sessions, the training program aims to improve teaching and inspiring skills for the course “Design your life”. It will also create connections, increase empathy among students and inspire learners, help them understand more deeply about life, encourage them to stay with their wishes, motivate them to change and have specific plans for their lives and develop open minds to learn and share.

In particular, the training program welcomed a special guest, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Ngo Minh Thuy – ULIS Former Vice President. She talked about her life and inspired others to live a positive and useful life, always be proactive and optimistic with all changes in life.

2. Seminar on happy living in a busy life

On July 20th, 2021, ULIS-VNU held a seminar under the theme “Living happily in a busy life”.

This is an activity in the series of Mindfulness seminars for staff, lecturers and teachers in order to develop their skills and foster their spirit.

In the program, the teachers shared their life experience and learned how to cope with pressure in modern life and apply Mindfulness.

The seminar was attended by more than 150 people.



3. Seminar on foreign language teacher training to adapt to competency framework of foreign language teachers in new context

On July 30th, 2021, ULIS-VNU held an online seminar under the topic “Foreign language teacher training to adapt to the competency framework of foreign language teachers in the new context”.



The seminar is part of the University’s development plan for the period 2021-2025, which is also an activity of the ULIS CONNECT Network, in order to create a forum for lecturers and others to meet and discuss foreign language teacher training issues in the current period.

Delivering her speech at the seminar, Vice President Ha Le Kim Anh said that the seminar was organized to introduce the activities which the University had been implementing related to foreign language teacher training as well as hoping to receive contributions and exchange ideas with lecturers and other interested people.

In the seminar, 3 presentations were delivered to nearly 600 participants.

4. ULIS biggest commencement in 2021

On July 29th, 2021, ULIS – VNU held the commencement to present the bachelor’s degrees to QH.2017.F1 students.



This is the biggest commencement of the school year with the attendance of 992 students and their parents (almost 2000 participants in total). The online ceremony was held in a professional manner with amazing innovations. Addressing the ceremony, President Do Tuan Minh extended his congratulations to the students on their graduation. In his inspirational speech, the President reminded the new graduates: “Be ULIS-er, be Cool. We are all winners. Be yourself, live your life and be happy. Be grateful and love your family. Be a better version of yourself everyday”.



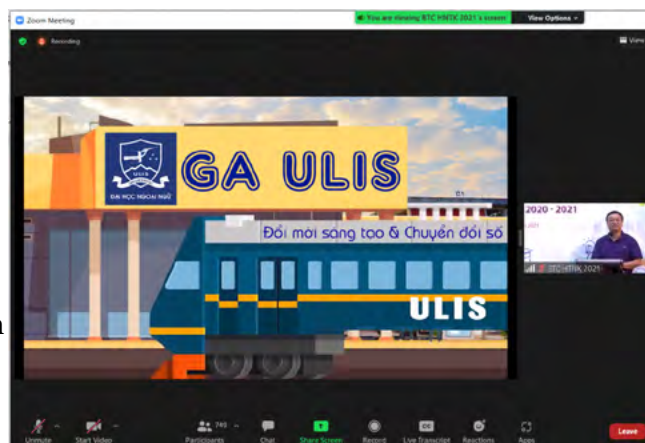
5. ULIS annual faculty and staff review conference of the 2020-2021 academic year

On August 6th, 2020, the University of Languages and International Studies – Vietnam National University, Hanoi (ULIS – VNU) held the ULIS annual faculty and staff review conference of the 2020-2021 academic year. To ensure the preventive measures during the COVID-19 pandemic, this year’s conference took place in an online platform.

The conference was attended by the Management Board and more than 700 civil servants and contracted workers of the University.

At the conference, President Do Tuan Minh presented reports on the university’s implementation of the Conference Resolution and tasks in 2020-2021 and the plan for 2021-2022.

Mr. Nguyen Van Doan, President of the Trade Union, then presented outcomes of the conferences in sub-units and collected comments and feedback. He also presented the report summarizing the activities of ULIS people’s inspectorate in 2020-2021.





The participants also listened to the report on budget management and welfare. Ms. Le Thi Khanh Trang, Director of Finance and Planning Office presented specific data on financial and planning activities in 2020-2021 and the plan for 2021-2022.

The conference program also included an awarding ceremony and other activities.

Delivering his speech at the conference, VNU President Le Quan acknowledged that the University had successfully organized the conference and hailed its high achievements in digital transformation. He suggested that the University make efforts to innovate, continue to focus on learners and digital transformation associated with all fields. The President of VNU praised ULIS for placing its primary focus on science and technology activities and hoped that the University would invest and develop in start-up activities.

6. Seminar on sharing information about translation and interpretation market in 2021

On August 9th, 2021, ULIS-VNU held an online seminar on sharing information about the translation and interpretation market in 2021.

The seminar was organized as part of the quality assurance plan on reviewing and improving the quality of training programs.

In the seminar, Ms. Duong Thi Hoai Chan – the keynote speaker, shared the current situation of the translation and interpretation industry.

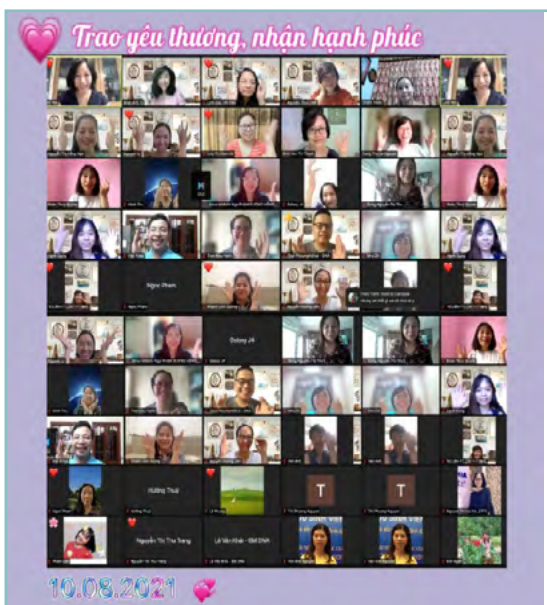
Ms. Duong Thi Hoai Chan also pointed out some difficulties when pursuing the career as a translator or interpreter and gave useful suggestions to ULIS students.



The seminar attracted about 100 participants.

7. Training course on Emotional Intelligence and Social Communication for ULIS staff held

In July and August 2021, ULIS-VNU organized a 10-session training course on Emotional Intelligence and Social Communication for its staff and lecturers.



Taking place in an online format, the training course aimed to foster morale and develop skills for the University staff.

The message throughout the course on Emotional Intelligence and Social Communication is “Be a lover- be a beloved” with 3 modules to help learners arouse emotions, nurture their loving soul and heart to be able to see life with loving eyes, listen with compassion, and love one another and so on.

The course has activities such as drinking tea in a different way, listening to music in a different way, singing in a different way, reviewing books in a different way and many others. The course itself is also delivered in a different and creative way.

Emotional Intelligence and Social Communication is a new module that will be officially taught from the 2021-2022 academic year.

8. ULIS supports the students in need due to Covid-19 pandemic

In order to support ULIS students who stay in Hanoi and are facing difficulties during the time of social distancing to prevent the Covid-19 pandemic, ULIS – VNU has implemented various meaningful activities.



On August 3rd, 2021, the University presented 250 giftpacks worth VND250,000 each to its students.

The University also launched a fundraiser to support its students. As of August 12th, the fund has received more than 187 million VND donated by staff and lecturers in the school and other individuals.

ULIS also set up a hotline for students in case they need support.

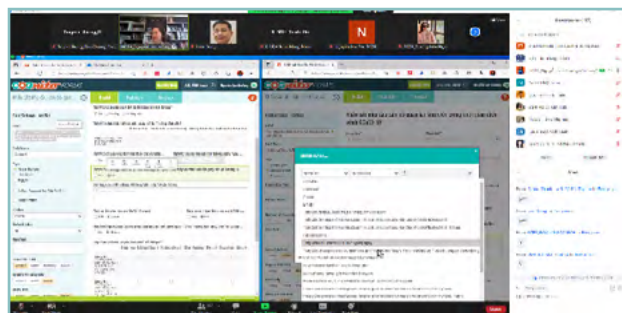
Currently, more than 600 students from provinces are living in dormitories or renting hostels across Hanoi, and some are living in very difficult situations. These activities demonstrate the University's efforts in supporting students and accompanying them to overcome difficult times.

9. Training course on using Cognito Forms for ULIS's staff organized

On August 19th and 26th, 2021, ULIS – VNU held two sessions of the training course on using Cognito Forms for its staff.

The training course is part of the school's training plan and digital transformation plan for this school year.

Addressing the training program, President Do Tuan Minh said that ULIS always actively supported its teachers to enhance the application of IT in their work. Cognito Forms has many features with high applicability, so teachers can apply it to their activities.



During the training program, Ms. Nguyen Thi Lan Huong, Deputy Director of the General Administration Office introduced Cognito Forms and shared about its features and strengths.

The staff were also guided to practice with the software. Thanks to its friendliness and useful features, Cognito Forms software promises to become a frequently used tool within the University in the time to come.

10. Food Banks Vietnam presented 118 giftpacks to ULIS's students

On August 27th, 2021, a charity group named Food Banks Vietnam presented 118 giftpacks to ULIS's students.



These gifts are part of Food Banks Vietnam’s “Love Credit” package, which is sent to students currently in the dormitory to support them during the social distancing period. Each pack includes 10kg of rice, a 500gram box of meat floss, a case of noodles, eggs, cakes and medical facemasks. The total value of the gifts is nearly 40 million VND.

Vice President Ha Le Kim Anh and Director of Politics and Students’ Affairs Office Vu Van Hai, on behalf of the University, received all the gifts and extended its thank to the Food Banks Vietnam.

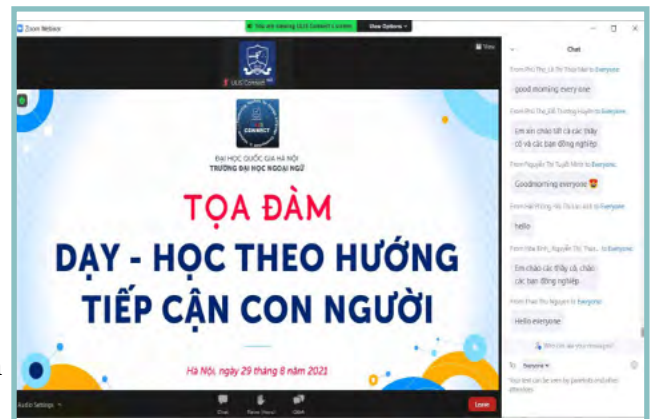
The student recipients were so thankful to all for the essential gifts in time of their great need.

11. Teaching and learning foreign languages with a human-oriented approach: Building and developing the capacity of authentic teachers and learners

On August 29th, 2021, ULIS-VNU held an online workshop for foreign language teachers at all levels under the topic “Teaching and learning foreign languages in a human-oriented approach: Building and developing the capacity of authentic teachers and learners”.

Delivering his speech at the workshop, President Do Tuan Minh said that this workshop was very special, it was organized to “turn risks into opportunities” with the desire to create a forum for teachers to participate in training courses, meet other foreign language teachers, develop skills and encourage one another to enter the new school year.

During the workshop, the delegates were provided with sharing about the problem of teaching foreign languages in a human-oriented approach and how to build and develop the capacity of authentic teachers and authentic learners.



The workshop “Teaching and learning foreign languages in a human-oriented approach: Building and developing the capacity of authentic teachers and learners” attracted about 3,000 participants.

12. Workshop on handling communication crises on social networks

In order to develop communication skills for its staff, contributing to improving the brand of each department in particular and the University in general, on August 31st, 2021, ULIS-VNU held a workshop on handling communication crises on social media.



Delivering his speech at the workshop, Vice President Nguyen Xuan Long said that the communication activities in the University had recorded many achievements in the past with more professionalism and wider coverage. However, communication requires updating and quick response. Therefore, this workshop was organized to help teachers gain more knowledge and skills to handle possible crises.

The workshop was divided into two main parts and attracted about 120 participants.

13. ULIS students become VNU Ambassadors of Reading Culture

ULIS’s students secured 12 of 36 prizes at the contest “VNU Ambassador of Reading Culture 2021”.

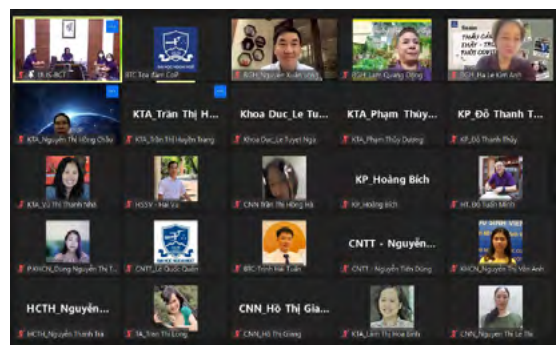
After nearly 4 months, the contest “VNU Ambassador of Reading Culture 2021” has attracted the participation of thousands of enthusiastic and talented young writers.

The contest received 4137 entries from students of 9 universities, 3 high schools, and 1 middle school. ULIS contributed over 3000 entries for the contest from students of all levels and the University’s students have secured 12 of 36 prizes of the contest.



14. Seminar on “Building professional community to create development opportunities”

On September 12th, 2021, ULIS-VNU held an online seminar under the topic “Building a professional community to create development opportunities”.

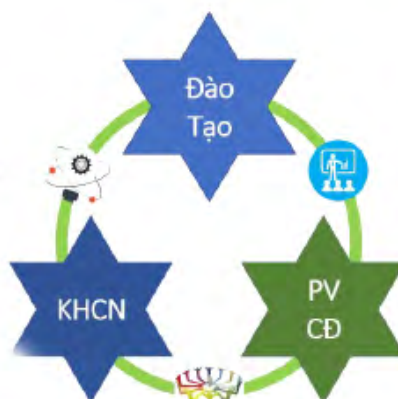


The seminar was organized to share basic knowledge about the community of professional development, or Community of Practice (COP) in higher education institutions today; discussing a number of proposals on the guidelines and organization of the activities, and scale, contents and products of COPs at ULIS; contributing to building orientations for the development of professional communities at ULIS in the coming time.

Delivering his speech at the seminar, President Do Tuan Minh said that COP was not new and covered all three main activities of the University, namely Training, Research and Community Services. During the program, 3 reports were presented. The seminar attracted more than 600 attendees.

The 20th Chinese Bridge Competition “Fuming Cup” for students in North and Central Vietnam took place successfully on September 15th, 2021.

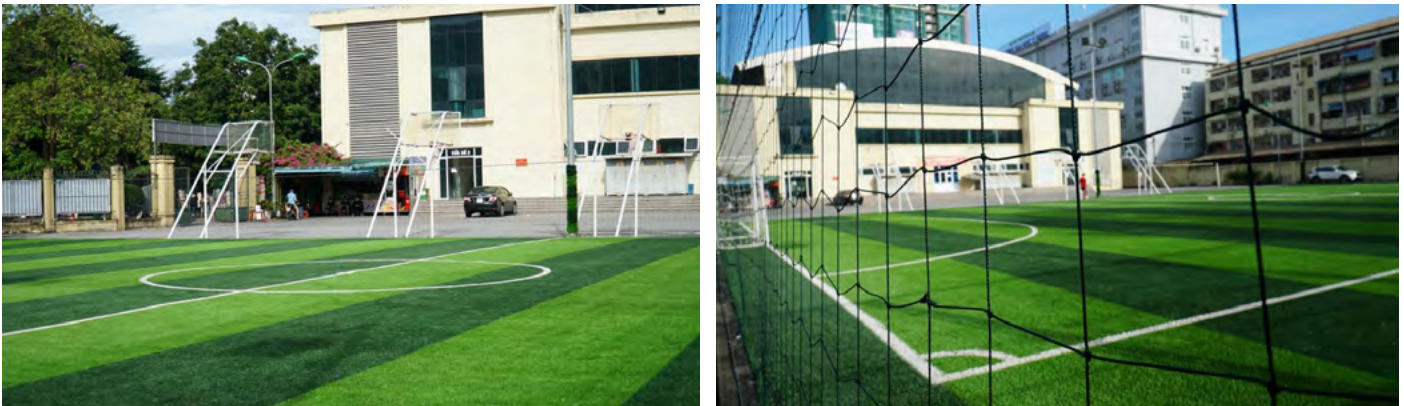

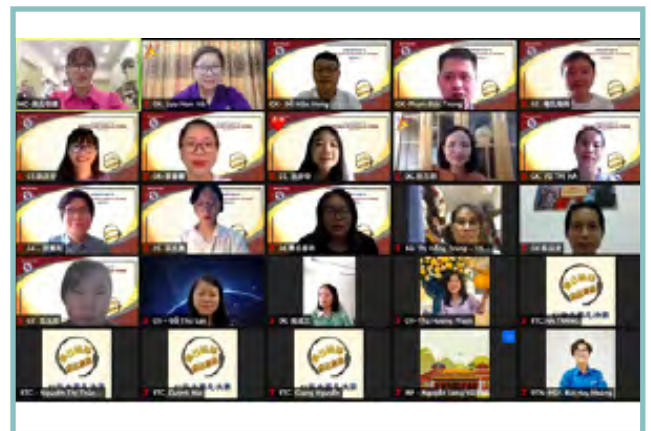
The program was then followed by the sharing of all the students and their dedication to their beloved teachers.

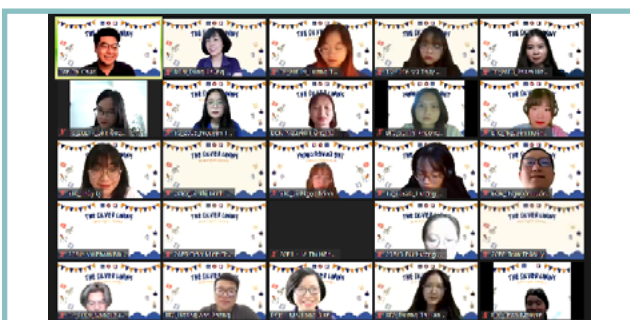

On August 9th, 2021, ULIS-VNU held the opening ceremony of the in-service course in English for staff and lecturers of Political University in 2021.

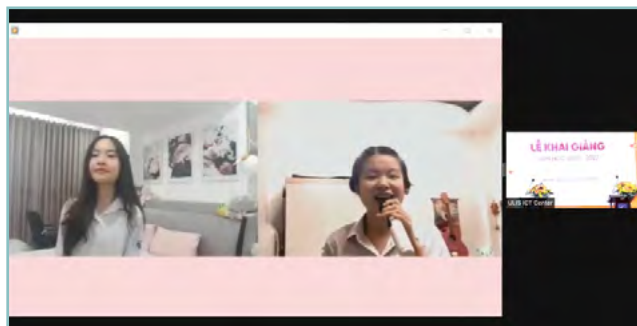
