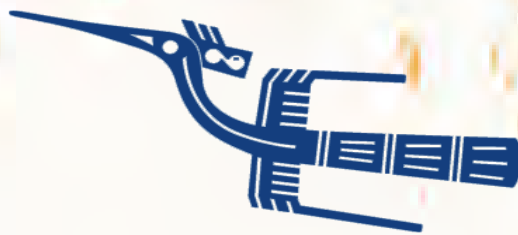

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I/ PROMINENT ACTIVITIES OF ULIS LEADERS

1. ULIS worked with the National Agency For Technology Entrepreneurship And Commercialization Development

On January 11th, 2022, ULIS-VNU held a meeting with the National Agency For Technology Entrepreneurship And Commercialization Development (Ministry of Science and Technology) to discuss cooperation activities between the two sides, especially in innovation and entrepreneurship.

During the meeting, ULIS's representatives shared about the current policies and practices of the university's innovation and entrepreneurship.

Vice President Ha Le Kim Anh emphasized that the University had paid special attention to innovation and entrepreneurship in teaching and scientific research in the past 3 years.



Through this sharing, the National Agency For Technology Entrepreneurship And Commercialization Development highly appreciated the interest of the University's leaders in innovation and entrepreneurship. The Department's leaders and experts also made many suggestions for the University to implement this activity more deeply, strongly and effectively.

At the end of the working session, both sides expressed their desire to cooperate more closely and more diversely in upcoming activities.

2. Meeting with Ha Thanh School on organizing internships for ULIS students

On January 13th, 2022, ULIS-VNU held a meeting with Ha Thanh School on organizing internships for students of the University.



During the meeting, the two sides exchanged and discussed cooperation activities, especially in organizing internships for ULIS students at Ha Thanh School.

Representatives of Ha Thanh School said that foreign language training features as one of its spearheads of development, so the school very much wishes to welcome ULIS interns and is committed to providing its best support for ULIS students.

Vice President Ha Le Kim Anh thanked the leaders of Ha Thanh School for supporting and facilitating ULIS students to do their internships at the school. The Vice President also proposed cooperation in the field of teacher development and training.

II/ COOPERATION & DEVELOPMENT

1. ULIS co-organizes global innovation program with HEC University, Montreal University and Foreign Trade University

On January 10th, 2022, Social Business Creation – Vietnam Hub under the management of Foreign Trade University successfully organized the Information and Connection Day: Kick-off Day within the framework of the Social Business Innovation Contest 2022.



Kick-off and Team-up Day SBC 2022 is an opportunity for those interested and registered for the SBC 2022 contest to learn more about the contest as well as to seek a matching member for their project.

On Kickoff Day SBC2022, SBC HUB officially announced that 11 universities and high schools from all over the North, Central and South regions, including ULIS – VNU, had officially joined the SBC HUB network to accompany Foreign Trade University to spread SBC's mission.

2. Cooperation agreement with Tokyo University of Foreign Studies, Japan signed

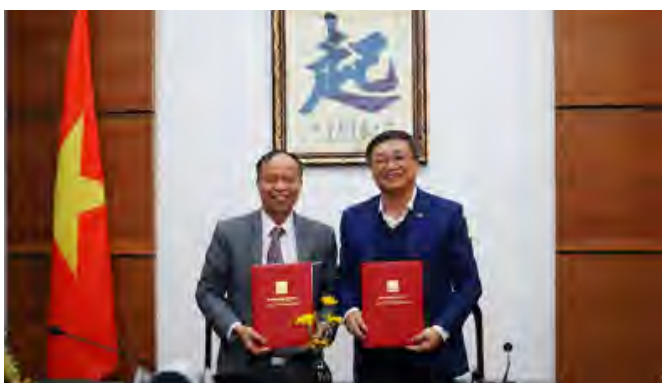
On January 19th, 2022, a signing ceremony took place on the establishment of the Global Japan Desk of Tokyo University of Foreign Studies, Japan at ULIS-VNU.

At the signing ceremony, representatives of the two universities signed a memorandum of understanding, establishing the Global Japan Desk of the Tokyo University of Foreign Studies, Japan on the 2nd floor, block A4, ULIS-VNU. The Desk is tasked with helping to enhance mutual understanding between Viet Nam and Japan and increase student exchange between the two universities and others.



3. Cooperation agreement with Ha Thanh School signed

On January 24th, 2022, a Memorandum of Understanding Signing Ceremony took place between ULIS-VNU and Ha Thanh School on professional internships for ULIS students.



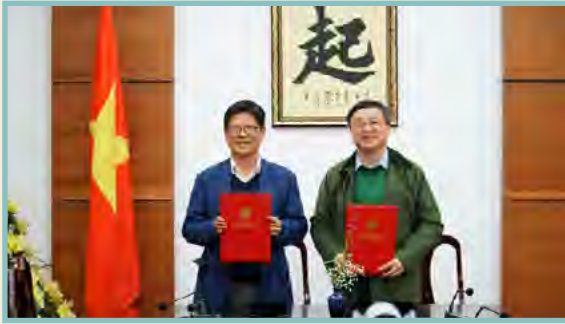
At the ceremony, representatives the two schools officially signed a memorandum of understanding, agreeing to cooperate in organizing internship for ULIS students at Ha Thanh School.

Speaking at the ceremony, representatives of the two schools highly appreciated the prospect of cooperation between the two sides, considering this a good opportunity to improve the efficiency in training and student affairs. The two sides also looked forward to expanding and implementing more cooperation activities with each other.

The ceremony marked the beginning of an important milestone for the cooperation relationship between ULIS – VNU and Ha Thanh School.

4. Cooperation activities with LG Display Hai Phong Company expanded

On February 10th, 2022, ULIS-VNU held a meeting and signed a cooperation agreement with LG Display Hai Phong Co., Ltd.



At the meeting, the two sides discussed cooperation in recruitment, internship arrangement, scholarship awarding and so on for ULIS students.

President Do Tuan Minh believed that the potentials for cooperation between two sides remain untapped to their full extent, made suggestions and proposed further expansion of cooperation activities.

Representatives of LG Display Company expressed their willingness to offer programs to attract university students for not only the position of translators and interpreters but also other jobs.

At the end of the program, the two sides' representatives signed an additional memorandum of understanding, adding new cooperation contents compared to the previous one signed in 2018.

5. The ceremony of awarding certificates on completion of training courses on testing for teachers of Hanoi Star School and announcing main results of review and evaluation report of the English program at the School

On February 19th, 2022, ULIS-VNU held a ceremony to award certificates on completion of training courses on testing for teachers of Hanoi Star School and announced the main results of the evaluation and review report of English program at the School.

At the beginning of the ceremony, Ms. Nguyen Thi Quynh Yen – Director of the Testing and Assessment Center presented the Training Course Summary Report, which highlighted the course cumulative results.

Then, the representative of the participants of the course shared their feelings and thoughts after participating in the course.



On behalf of ULIS-VNU, and Hanoi Star Middle and High School, President Do Tuan Minh and Ms. Pham Bich Nga – President of the School presented certificates of course completion to the students.

After that, all the participants joined a discussion session on 10 recommendations related to the English curriculum chaired by President Do Tuan Minh. The groups delivered in-depth presentation and shared many ideas to further improve the teaching of English programs.

6. Cooperation agreement between ULIS-VNU and Department of Education and Training of Lang Son province signed

7. BOOK DONATION BY READ JAPAN PROJECT

On December 28th, 2021, ULIS-VNU received 163 books from READ JAPAN PROJECT, which aimed at increasing the knowledge about Japan; the project is sponsored by Nippon Foundation and jointly organized by Japanese Embassy in Viet Nam and the Japan Science Association.

The READ JAPAN PROJECT is an opportunity to further the relationship between Viet Nam and Japan, and encourage the young people in Viet Nam to endeavor at work.

This year, Vietnam topped the list with the highest number of recipients of the Project's donation compared to other countries, and ULIS is one among 9 Vietnamese universities which benefits from the



III/ PROMINENT ACTIVITIES OF THE UNIVERSITY

1. Concert “ULIS HOA CA” held

On January 9th, 2022, ULIS-VNU held the “ULIS HOA CA” concert in an online platform.

The event celebrated the 72nd anniversary of the traditional day of Vietnamese students (January 9th, 1950 – January 9th, 2022), the 21st ULIS Youth Union Congress and also raised funds for the Green Dream Scholarship. The program is also a meaningful gift to students, trainees, staff, lecturers, alumni, former teachers and partners of the university.

Delivering his opening remarks, President Do Tuan Minh emphasized that it was ULIS decision to organize the concert “ULIS HOA CA”, an event that had been long cherished, to mark the 72nd anniversary of the traditional day of Vietnamese students. Also, the anniversary was commemorated with the launch of 4 new student clubs, including Rugby Club, Young Reasoning Club, Financial Investment Club and Book Club, which added skill-training playgrounds for ULISers in the University’s realization of its experiential learning approach



At the beginning of the program, the audience watched a video about the 19-year journey of the Green Dream Scholarship. On this occasion, the Scholarship received more than 560 million VND, which will be granted to more than 200 students.

After that, the concert officially began with live performances and recorded music videos from teachers and staff of all departments, partners, students and alumni of the university. All are unique performances, expressing an exciting and very meaningful spirit of ULIS’s youth.

2. Closing of 2nd course of foreign language teaching skills for students majoring in foreign languages

On January 10th, 2022, ULIS-VNU held the closing ceremony of the second course of the foreign language teaching skills for students majoring in foreign languages in an online platform.



Delivering her opening speech, Vice President Ha Le Kim Anh shared that the main purpose of the course is to support the development of teaching skills for students majoring in foreign languages, providing students with an opportunity to access to suitable jobs in the future.

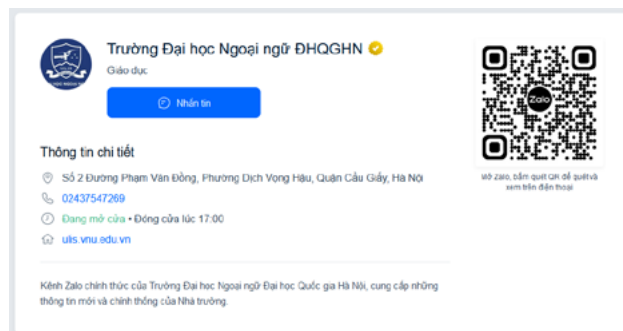
Afterwards, Ms. Ta Nhat Anh – Lecturer in the Department of Educational Psychology summarized the activities and results of the course.

This is the second year of this VNU award.

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7. Students begin to return to face-to-face study

On February 7th, 2022, foreign students studying Vietnamese began to study onsite again at ULIS-VNU. These are the first classes to return to face-to-face teaching and learning at the university after a long online learning period.



On the occasion of the beginning of the year of the Tiger in 2022 and welcoming students to return to face-to-face classes, President Do Tuan Minh paid his visit and extended his wishes to the overseas students.

Speaking on the occasion of the new year, the President extended his best wishes for health, success and acknowledged the efforts of international students when deciding to come to Viet Nam to study Vietnamese and establish a career.

Currently, the university is still actively implementing many measures to organize safe face-to-face learning to ensure maximum prevention of COVID-19 for students, especially when many classes will return to school in the coming time.

Also on this occasion, President Do Tuan Minh and Dean of Faculty of Foreign Language Education and Professional Development Hoa Ngoc Son represented the school to present lucky money to foreign students.

8. ULIS Innovation Center established

On February 7th, 2022, at the meeting on the occasion of the beginning of the lunar new year, ULIS-VNU announced the establishment of the Innovation Center under the University. Ms. Nguyen Thi Ngoc Anh was appointed the Center Director.

On January 21st, 2022, ULIS President signed the Decision to establish ULIS Innovation Center.

ULIS INNOVATION CENTER – UI inherits and promotes the activities and achievements of the FIRE Project in order to promote innovation, scientific research and entrepreneurship among students toward promoting autonomy, dynamism and creativity, improving self-study, experience, discovery and research capacity for students, and contributing to creating knowledge and products with great applications for society.



9. Opening of the training course “Exploitation of open learning resources of the Online Professional English Network (OPEN) in teaching English and enhancing foreign language teaching methods”

On February 19th, 2022, ULIS-VNU held the opening ceremony of the training course “Exploitation of open learning resources of the Online Professional English Network (OPEN) in teaching English and enhancing foreign language teaching methods.”



At the beginning of the opening ceremony, President Do Tuan Minh emphasized the importance of the course and affirmed that the students after the course would gain a lot of knowledge and skills that would help them to not only improve their professional skills, but also become ones who share and spread those knowledge and skills to a large number of interested people.

Then, Mr. Jerrold Frank, Director of the Regional English Language Office (RELO), the US Embassy in Viet Nam – Partner of the course, thanked ULIS for coordinating with the Office to organize the course and wished success to all students.

Right after that, the first content of the course was deployed and shared to the students. The course will take place in 3 face-to-face training sessions in addition to other useful online training activities.

10. Seminar “Orientation to develop Transnational Culture and Communication Major at ULIS-VNU”

On February 22nd, 2022, ULIS-VNU held the seminar “Orientation to develop the Transnational Culture and Communication Major at ULIS-VNU”. This is the kickoff of the development of Translational Culture and Communication Major at the University.

In his opening remark, President Do Tuan Minh said that the Transnational Culture and Communication Major to be offered as a Bachelor program is one of the key tasks of the university in 2022.

At the seminar, 3 reports were presented, followed by an exchange and discussion session. Many comments and suggestions about the program delivery, curriculum structure, outcome standards, and other issues, were raised.



To conclude the workshop, Vice President Ha Le Kim Anh emphasized that developing the Transnational Culture and Communication Major is an important task and should be carefully implemented step by step to create a high-quality program which meet the needs of society.

11. ULIS Bachelor Program in the Russian Language accredited by AUN-QA

On February 21st-25th, 2022, within the framework of the 259th assessment in compliance with AUN-QA standards for training programs of VNU, ULIS worked with the assessment team on accreditation of the Russian Language Undergraduate Program. The assessment was conducted in an online platform.

During the evaluation mission, AUN assessment team of AUN collected information about facilities, worked with leaders of schools, faculties and functional units, interviewed lecturers, alumni, recruiters, and others. According to the preliminary report at the closing session of the assessment, the Russian Language Undergraduate Program is spoken with high regard for its excellent services, facilities, lecturers, etc.



12. Counseling program on 3rd course of foreign language teaching skills for students held

On March 1st, 2022, ULIS, VNU held an online counseling session on the third course of foreign language teaching skills. After the success of the previous two courses, the third course promises to continue bringing useful knowledge and skills to students of the University.



At the beginning of the session, Vice President Ha Le Kim Anh briefly introduced the course and shared the benefits and implications that the course offers.

Also in the program, representatives of the Department of Educational Psychology shared information and tentative schedule of the 3rd course of foreign language teaching skills.

The last part of the program was a Q&A session, where many of the questions were answered in details. The students all expressed their desire to attend classes of the course soon.

The course is expected to start on March 21st, 2022.

13. Conference of ULIS Alumni in 2022

On March 25th, 2022, ULIS-VNU held a conference to review the activities of ULIS Alumni in 2021 with the participation of more than 150 delegates.

In his opening speech, Chairman of the Executive Committee of ULIS Alumni Nguyen Lan Trung said: “Since the Congress on March 27th, 2021, the Network has connected with many former students to cooperate, share, support and connect with the University, as well as with the students to support them. The initial results are a positive signal for the Network to make more efforts to develop.”

During the conference, the delegates listened to the contributions and sharing of representatives of branches, sub-divisions and clubs of ULIS Alumni.

Delivering his speech at the Conference, President Do Tuan Minh reaffirmed the important role of the ULIS Alumni Network.

At the Conference, the University awarded certificates of merit to members and collectives who made many positive contributions to the Network’s activities last year.



IV/ PROMINENT ACTIVITIES OF DEPARTMENTS

1. Finale of Exploring Japanese Culinary Culture contest held

On January 8th, 2022, the finale of the Exploring Japanese Culinary Culture Contest for QH2021 students majoring in the Japanese language was successfully concluded. This is a cultural experience activity organized by the Faculty of Japanese Language and Culture with the participation of 9 talented teams.



Taking place in an online platform, the teams devoted themselves to the best performances which convincingly fascinated both the judges and the audience.

QH2021 students of the Faculty also had the chance to experience Japanese culture, particularly Japanese culinary art, through the contest, and, definitely they all offered the contest very positive feedback.

2. International Conference “Korean studies from Southeast Asian perspective”

On January 14th, 2022, ULIS-VNU held an international conference “Korean studies from Southeast Asian perspective”. This is an activity within the framework of the ULIS AKS CORE project sponsored by the Korea Development Fund – Korea Central Institute of Korean Studies.

ULIS AKS CORE Project Director Tran Thi Huong said that 2021 was a difficult year with unpredictable spread of the pandemic, but ULIS implementation of this key project on Korean training and research had never been interrupted.

President Do Tuan Minh shared that Korean language teaching in Viet Nam is turning to a new page, developing in a very strong and promising manner.



The Conference received a total of 24 quality papers from domestic and foreign scholars.

At the beginning of the conference, Prof. Han Do Hyun, the keynote speaker, shared interesting and meaningful contents around the topic: “Korean studies and its fascination: Miracle about Korea and Korean Studies”.

8 speakers presented their speeches at the plenary session of the conference, while 18 others were presented at 3 parallel sessions.

3. Finale and award ceremony of “French comic composition” contest for QH2021 students

On January 13th, 2022, within the framework of experiential activities of QH2021 students, the Division of French 1, Faculty of French Language and Culture successfully organized the finale and award ceremony of the contest “French comic composition” for its students.

At the beginning of the program, Ms. Dam Minh Thuy – Vice Dean of Faculty of French Language and Culture extended her compliments to all QH2021 students for enthusiastically participating in the contest despite their short time of learning French.

After the organizers announced 10 excellent entries selected for the final round, the authors introduced their works to the judges, teachers and guests. The works covered diverse themes, including family, friends and online learning.



The final round and award ceremony of the contest “French comic composition” reaped significant success, leaving many emotions and beautiful images in the hearts of the participants. Prizes were awarded to deserving teams.

4. Workshop on sharing values and importance of speed reading in the process of personal development

On February 26th, 2022, ULIS-VNU held the workshop “Sharing the values and importance of speed reading in the process of personal development”. This is a periodical activity organized by the Center for Information Technology, Communication and Learning Resources.



The speaker of the seminar is Mr. Doan Son Lam, speed reading training expert, Chairman of the Board of Directors of Nagara Corporation and coach in applying knowledge from books into practice.

During the workshop, the speaker helped students overcome their laziness in reading, temptation for sleep while reading and worry of forgetting everything after reading by sharing the meanings of reading.

After the workshop, the organizers and speaker encouraged the attending students to read a favorite book, especially a book on the topic of personal development to achieve maximum effectiveness, as well as presented a gift to students taking part in the workshop, which is a 50% reduction of tuition fees for all courses delivered by speaker Doan Son Lam.



5. ULIS students learn about social life of Thai people with Harvard Professor

On March 5th, 2022, ULIS students had an exchange session with Prof. Michael Herzfeld, from the Department of Anthropology at Harvard University, the USA.

The lecture with the theme “Semantic mapping and abstract concepts: Urban beauty and community order in the social life of Thai people” is part of the course Introduction to Asian Community.

During the lesson, Prof. Michael Herzfeld – lecturer at Harvard University, the USA, introduced to ULIS students the concepts of semantic mapping and abstract concepts of beauty and urban community order in Thailand. He asserted that the ‘aesthetics’ from the Thai point of view is very special, class-based and often influenced by the Western culture. He also gave real examples of words for beauty, beautiful clothes, beautiful food, beautiful toilet paper, beautiful buildings, in the urban life of Thai people.



6. UMS students secured impressive results at the Examination for Excellent Students in Cau Giay District for the school year 2021-2022

The school year 2021-2022 with the stressful and complicated pandemic situation has caused students to suffer many disadvantages in the process of learning and training. However, UMS teachers and students have overcome difficulties and secured impressive achievements.

Continuing a wide range of activities within the framework of UNC2022, on January 9th, 2022, ULIS-VNU organized an intensive training course on building and implementing blended foreign language courses. The training course is a part of the series program within the framework of UNC 2022, hosted by ULIS-VNU, in collaboration with the Regional English Language Office of the US Embassy.
