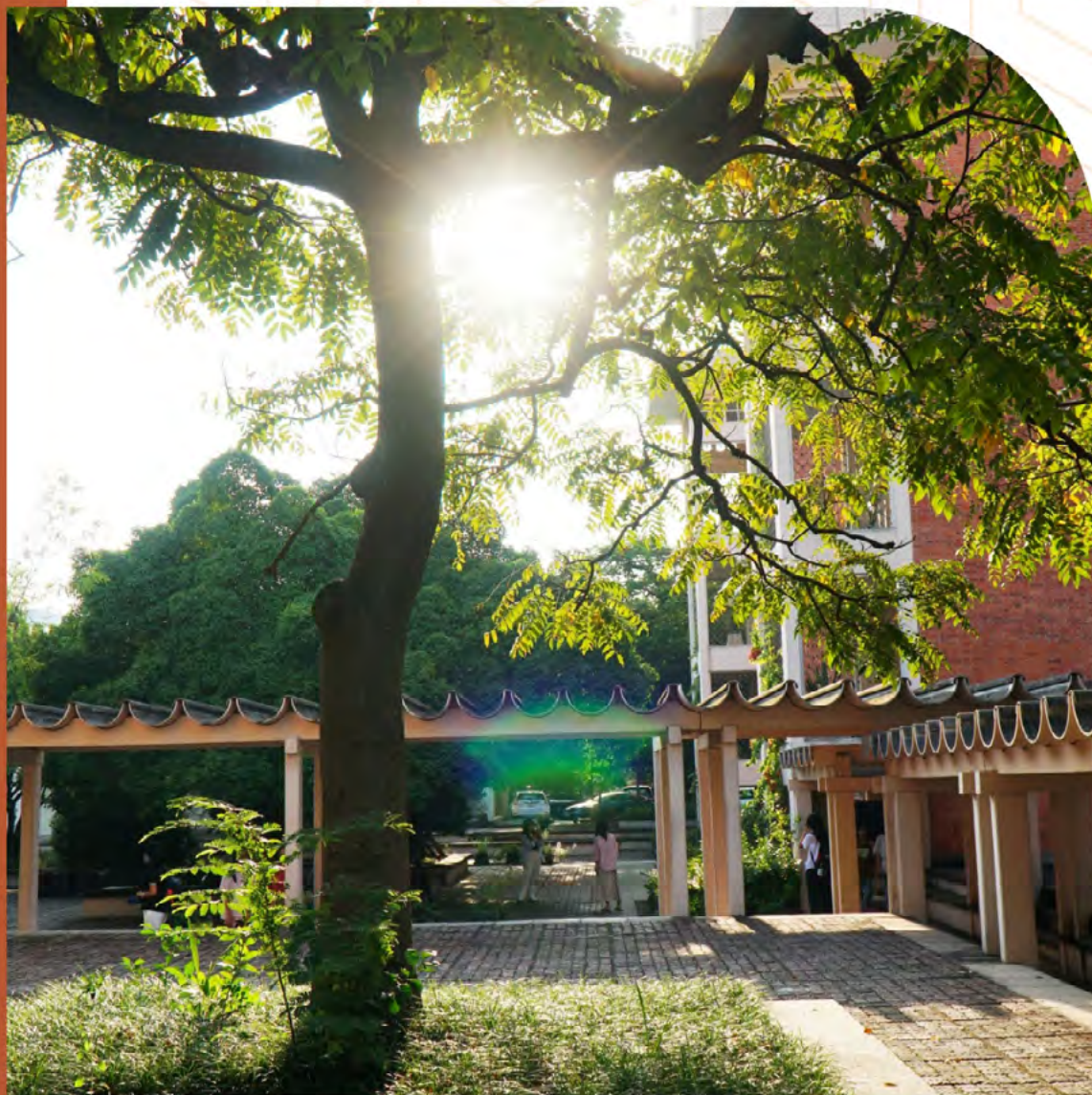

I/ PROMINENT ACTIVITIES OF ULIS LEADERS

1. Innovation, Digital Transformation and Workplan for July-August 2023

On 12th – 14th, 2023, ULIS-VNU held a conference to evaluate the implementation results of innovation projects in the school year of 2022-2023, review 3-years’ implementation of the digital transformation plan for the period 2020-2025 and outline ULIS workplan in July-August 2023.

Delivering his speech at the Conference, Chairman of the University Council – Dr. Do Tuan Minh affirmed that “innovation” and “digital transformation” were interrelated and extremely familiar to ULIS over the past years. In the academic year 2022-2023, 24 departments had fully completed two rounds of the innovation competition, of which 10 excellent departments had made it to the finale.

In the conference, 10 best projects presented their implementation results.



Also, the preliminary report of 03 years of implementing the digital transformation plan for the period 2020-2025 at the University was delivered, summarizing the achievements in the period 2020-2023 and proposing action directions for the rest of the period.

A discussion session then vibrantly took place with six groups.

At the end of the conference, ULIS workplan in July and August 2023 was presented, reviewing activities in July and set out orientations for the coming time.

The conference closed after an active and exciting working session, promising further success of the University’s innovation projects and digital transformation plan in the time to come.



2. Chairman of ULIS University Council, ULIS President and Vice President Take Office

On August 8th, 2023, ULIS-VNU held the ceremony to announce the decisions on recognizing the Chairman of ULIS University Council, ULIS President and reappointing ULIS Vice President.



At the ceremony, VNU President Le Quan presented the decisions on recognizing Dr. Do Tuan Minh as the Chairman of ULIS University Council and recognizing Dr. Nguyen Xuan Long as ULIS President.

Also at the ceremony, Chairman of ULIS University Council Do Tuan Minh handed over the decision on reappointing Assoc. Prof. Dr. Lam Quang Dong as ULIS Vice President.

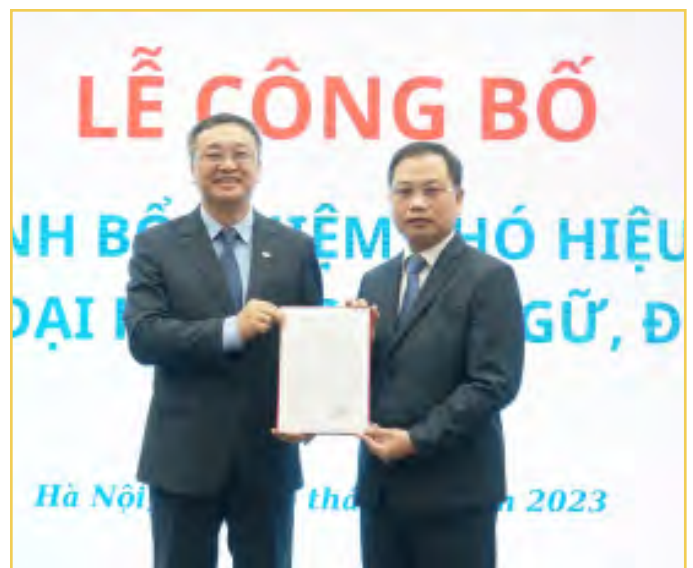


3. Dr. Hoa Ngoc Son appointed ULIS Vice President

On September 11th, 2023, the ULIS University Council passed Resolution No. 2099/NQ-HDT on the appointment of leadership and management personnel. Accordingly, Dr. Hoa Ngoc Son was appointed ULIS Vice President for the 2023-2028 term.

Dr. Hoa Ngoc Son was born on April 1st, 1977. He is a former FLSS student. In 2005, when turning 28, he completed the PhD program in modern Chinese at Nanjing Normal University (China) and returned Vietnam to work at ULIS – VNU.

Before being appointed as Vice President, he held leadership positions (such as Director of the Center for International Education, Dean of the Faculty of Language Education and Professional Development) and made many contributions in developing international partnership training programs, in-service programs, local projects and cooperative activities with the National Foreign Language Project.





II/ COOPERATION & DEVELOPMENT

1. Exchange between ULIS and Ritsumeikan University (Japan)

On August 13th, 2023, ULIS-VNU organized an exchange with students and teachers from Ritsumeikan University (Japan).



The exchange started with a lively performance from talented students of the Faculty of Japanese Language and Culture.

Delivering his speech at the exchange, Mr. Pham Dinh Luong - Deputy Director of Politics & Student Affairs Office said that ULIS had been organizing many exchange activities with Japanese universities for many years, including academic and cultural exchanges.

On behalf of Ritsumeikan University, Dr. Ikoma Tomokazu, head of the delegation believed that connections and exchanges like this contributed to motivating students of the two countries to learn and love traditions and cultures of Vietnam and Japan.

During the exchange, the students had the opportunity to experience numerous interesting activities.

2. Cooperation agreement with The Vietnam Foundation (VNF) signed

On August 18th, 2023, ULIS - VNU held a signing ceremony of cooperation with The Vietnam Foundation (VNF).



At the ceremony, representatives of ULIS and The Vietnam Foundation signed an official memorandum of understanding (MOU). Both sides agreed to strengthen cooperation and support the development of foreign language learning movements, and active and innovative education in Vietnam.

Delivering his speech at the ceremony, President Nguyen Xuan Long expressed his deep interest in the open school and class programs introduced by Khan Academy Vietnam.

Chairman of the University Council Do Tuan Minh emphasized that the cooperation between the two sides offered various potentials, and it was crucial to translate the signed MOU into reality for true efficacy.

Representatives from VNF expressed their agreement with the proposals and suggestions from ULIS leaders. The cooperation certainly brings benefits to both parties as well as the community at large.

3. Cooperation with VNU Library and Digital Knowledge Center strengthened

On August 30th, 2023, ULIS-VNU held a meeting with VNU Library and Digital Knowledge Center to discuss cooperation activities and support for learners in the coming time.

At the meeting, the two sides exchanged and discussed cooperation in resource sharing activities, further digitalization of textbooks and documents of faculties, especially the Faculty of Korean Language and Culture to serve students in training and scientific research.

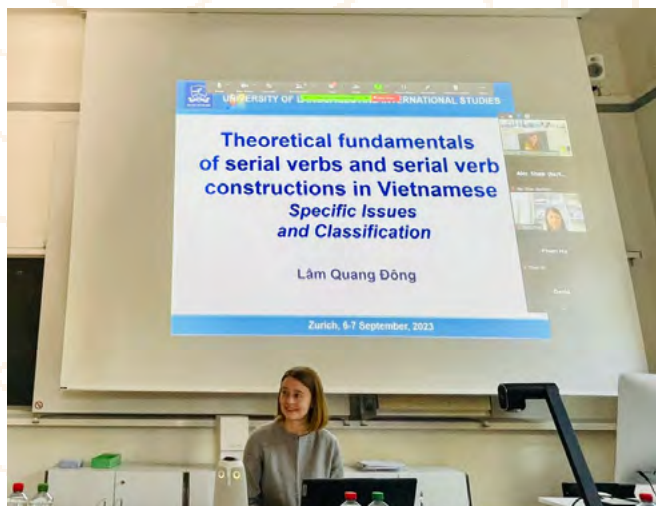
In addition, representatives of the two sides also agreed on solutions to solve the obstacles and difficulties that lecturers and students are facing in searching and using resources.



Addressing the meeting, Vice President Lam Quang Dong expressed his wish that the two sides would regularly exchange information to strengthen cooperation and support joint activities.

4. ULIS - VNU coordinates with University of Zurich, Switzerland to organize Workshop “Topics in Vietnamese Linguistics”

Within the cooperation between the University of Zurich (UZH, Switzerland) and ULIS - VNU, the Workshop on Topics in Vietnamese Linguistics was jointly organized by the two universities with the participation of international scholars, undergraduate and graduate students from the two universities on September 6th – 7th, 2023.



After all presentations, a lively discussion was held to delve into arguments, evidence, and phenomena from research materials as well as natural language, ushering in further research directions in Vietnamese linguistics for scholars, undergraduate and graduate students who are interested in and passionate about Vietnamese at the two universities.

Addressing the event, representatives from the University of Zurich spoke highly the cooperation effectiveness and the important role of ULIS in the research project on the language acquisition of children, including Vietnamese children.

The conference ended with new and feasible prospects for a long-term and effective scientific and training cooperation relationship between the two universities.

5. ULIS lecturers participate in training course on Innovation for Sustainable Development at Innovation Academy, University College Dublin, Ireland (IA-UCD)

On August 5th-20th, 2023, 4 ULIS lecturers had the opportunity to participate in the training course on Innovation for Sustainable Development at the Innovation Academy, University College Dublin, Ireland (IA-UCD). The program is sponsored by IrishAid through the Irish Embassy in Vietnam within the framework of the Vietnam-Ireland bilateral cooperation project jointly implemented by IA-UCD and VNU.

14 innovative educators from VNU participated in this program, which is equivalent to a 3-credit course, including a 3-day fieldtrip.



6. Staff of iSMART Company to Become more Inspiring Educators

On June 29th – 30th, 2023, ULIS-VNU in collaboration with the Education Company iSMART Hanoi organized a training course on “Inspiring Educators” for 40 employees of the company. This was one of the cooperation activities between the two institutions after signing the official MOU in April.



During the program, all participants took part in many activities to raise awareness, develop skills, discover their own potentials, and exchange with others.

Delivering her speech at the closing ceremony of the course, Vice President Ha Le Kim Anh believed that competent staff of iSmart had been able to learn from one another and hone their skills to become smarter and more inspiring as educators. She also hoped that ULIS and iSMART would have more cooperation activities in the future, bringing practical efficiency to both sides.

III/ PROMINENT ACTIVITIES OF THE UNIVERSITY

1. ULIS annual faculty, staff and review conference of the 2022-2023 academic year

On August 8th, 2023, the University of Languages and International Studies – Vietnam National University, Hanoi (ULIS – VNU) held the ULIS annual faculty, staff and review conference of the 2022-2023 academic year.

The conference was attended by the University Council, the Management Board and more than 800 lecturers and staff from all units within the University.

At the conference, President Nguyen Xuan Long presented reports on the implementation of the Conference's Resolution, tasks in 2022-2023 school year and plan for 2023-2024 school year.



Mr. Nguyen Van Doan then presented the outcomes of state official and staff conference in affiliated units and collected comments and feedback. He also presented the report summarizing the activities of the People's Inspectorate during the school year.

The conference also listened to the report on budget management and welfare. Ms. Le Thi Khanh Trang, Lead Accountant, Director of Finance and Planning Office presented specific data on finance and planning activities in 2022-2023 school year and the plan for 2023-2024 school year.

The conference agenda also included an awarding ceremony and other activities.

2. [UNC2024] Meeting of four universities on cooperation to organize an international conference within UNC2024

On July 18th, 2023, leaders and staff of Hanoi University of Science and Technology, National Economics University and International School - VNU held a meeting at ULIS-VNU to discuss the plan for jointly organizing an international conference under the theme "Teaching English for Specific Purposes: Perspectives, Policies and Practices". This conference is part of a wide range of events within UNC 2024.



At the meeting, Dr. Nguyen Thi Ngoc Quynh - Director of Science and Technology Office presented the draft plan to organize the conference. Many opinions and suggestions from the participants were proposed to the organizing committee.

Leaders of the universities expressed their impression on the professionalism and prestige of UNC and agreed to organize this international conference to continue this series of inspirational events.

Representatives of the universities together agreed on details of the plan to organize the conference and also expressed their desire to implement other cooperation activities in the future.

3. Opening ceremony of "ULIS SUCCESS – Preparation for the future" training course

On July 18th, 2023, ULIS-VNU held the opening ceremony of the "ULIS SUCCESS – Preparation for the future" training course for candidates who had applied for admission and 12th grade students who were interested in studying at ULIS.

The course aims to create an opportunity for students to experience college study like a tertiary student even before college admission, accumulating knowledge of the module “Additional skills” in the undergraduate program and gradually get used to the university learning environment.

Delivering his speech at the event, Chairman of the University Council – Dr. Do Tuan Minh said “ULIS is not only waiting to welcome future students, but we also want to give you the opportunity to experience the academic activities of a tertiary student right now”.



The course takes place in an online platform with five sessions, corresponding to five different topics: Topic 1: Positioning yourself in the university environment; Topic 2: Time management & personal finance; Topic 3: Personal branding; Topic 4: Developing Emotional Intelligence and Topic 5: Mastering the present to firmly step into the future. The course provides the participants with valuable knowledge and interesting experiences.

4. Summary of the ULIS Success course and the “Ulisers’ Courage” contest

On August 29th, 2023, ULIS - VNU organized a trip to summarize the ULIS Success course and the “Ulisers’ Courage” contest.



Representative of the course organizers, Ms. Nguyen Thuy Lan presented the final report of the ULIS Success course. She said that students who completed the course would receive a certificate as well as the highest mark for the entire module “Successful Study Skills at Higher Education” after officially becoming new students of the university.

Also, in the summary of the contest “Ulisers’ Courage”, the university honored and presented prizes to the top 20 excellent students of the contest.

5. Commencement for QH.2019 students majoring in economics and finance

On July 19th, 2023, ULIS-VNU held a commencement ceremony to present Bachelor’s degree in economics and finance (jointly offered with Southern New Hampshire University – the United States) to 35 QH.2019 students at ULIS Sunwah Hall.

Addressing the ceremony, Vice President Ha Le Kim Anh extended her congratulations to the students majoring in economics and finance. She wished them all success in their future.

The ceremony closed with many memorable moments. It was an emotional and pridesworthy time of the new graduates.



5. Seminar “Academic Publication in International Journals and Publishers: Making Smarter Choices”

On August 10th, 2023, ULIS-VNU organized the seminar “Academic Publication in International Journals and Publishers: Making Smarter Choices” for ULIS graduate students and lecturers.



The seminar was organized to create opportunities for ULIS graduate students and lecturers to have more knowledge and understanding about international publication.

At the seminar, the speaker presented and shared his experiences on academic publication in international journals and publishers, thereby giving useful tips to participants.

After sharing useful information about international publications, the students and lecturers were actively engaged in practical exercises.

6. Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong and Prime Minister Pham Minh Chinh visit ULIS

20 excellent ULIS students were honored to participate in the exchange program at Sunwah Hall. These are all students with high achievements in study, extracurricular activities, voluntary work, etc. They confidently discussed with the politicians many issues of their interest.

After that, Prime Minister Pham Minh Chinh and Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong had an intimate lunch with VNU students at the canteen of B2 building, where the two Prime Ministers enjoyed famous traditional Vietnamese dishes such as “banh cuon cha”, “bun thang”, Hanoi spring rolls, nuggets, etc.



7. Commencement for students of in-service program in English language of Hanoi University of Home Affairs

11. ULIS participates in 9th annual conference of AALA and AFELTA in Japan

Within the framework of the 9th Annual Conference of the Asian Association for Language Assessment (AALA) and the Academic Forum on English Language Testing in Asia (AFELTA) held in Japan on September 2nd-6th, 2023, the ULIS delegation led by Dr. Nguyen Thi Ngoc Quynh (Director of the Science and Technology Office) participated and contributed two quality presentations as well as exchanged and discussed cooperative projects in foreign language training and assessment in Asia.



At the AALA Conference, the delegation presented on “Classroom-based assessment practices in Vietnam: the what and the why”. The presentation is the product of collaborative research between ULIS-VNU and the University of Huddersfield (UK).

Within the AFELTA Forum, the report of the delegation focused on providing a professional development framework for those who develop exam technical specifications.

In addition, the delegation interacted, connected and held several meetings with representatives of testing centers and units in Asia.

12. Opening ceremony of exchange training course for international students from Guangxi University for Nationalities, China

IV/ PROMINENT ACTIVITIES OF DEPARTMENTS

1. FLSS students win high prizes at the Competition for Excellent Students in the Northern Coast and Red River Delta region in 2023

On July 15th – 16th, 2023, the delegation of FLSS teachers and students participated in the 14th Competition for Excellent Students in the Northern Coast and Red River Delta region in 2023 in Thai Nguyen Province.



The results are as follows: 18 of 20 students secured prizes, accounting for 90.0%, including 3 Gold medals, 4 Silver medals, 6 Bronze medals and 5 Consolation prizes.
