MA. PROGRAMMES (FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS)**

1. General Information

The University of Languages and International Studies (ULIS), Vietnam National University (VNU), Hanoi currently offers **9 Master of Arts (MA)** programmes, including:

MA Programmes in Linguistics

- Applied Linguistics (English)
- English Linguistics
- Russian Linguistics
- French Linguistics
- Chinese Linguistics
- German Linguistics
- Japanese Linguistics
- Korean Linguistics
- German as a Foreign and Second Language in the Vietnamese–German Context (a joint programme with Leipzig University, Federal Republic of Germany)

MA Programmes in Language Teaching Methodology

- English Language Teaching Methodology
- Russian Language Teaching Methodology
- French Language Teaching Methodology
- Chinese Language Teaching Methodology

2. Entry Requirements

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

Academic qualification

A Bachelor's degree in one of the following fields:

- Linguistics (English, Russian, French, Chinese, German, Japanese, or Korean)
- Language Teaching Methodology (English, Russian, French, or Chinese)

Language proficiency

Applicants must provide one of the following:

- Vietnamese proficiency: **Level 4/6 (B2)** according to the Vietnamese Language Proficiency Framework, or
- English proficiency: **B2 level** according to the **Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)**

3. Programme Structure

Each MA programme consists of **61 credits**, including a **9–15 credit MA thesis or project**.

4. Training Duration

The programme requires **two years of full-time study**, including at least **18 consecutive months of on-campus coursework**.

Students may be granted **an extension of up to one additional year** in special circumstances.

5. Tuition Fees

Tuition fees for international students are **subject to annual adjustment**.

Current fees:

- Tuition fee: **52,000,000 VND per year** (approximately **USD 2,100**)
- Registration fee: **USD 200**

Additional expenses

- Visa fee: **USD 135 per year** (regulated by the Immigration Department, Ministry of Public Security, Vietnam)
- Accommodation (optional):
 - Shared room (6 students): **USD 40/month**
 - Single room: **USD 250/month**

Note:

Students will be assisted in obtaining a **multiple-entry study visa** upon arrival at international airports in Vietnam. Tuition fees must be paid before visa support is processed.

6. Degree Awarded

Upon successful completion of the programme, students will receive a **Master of Arts (MA)** degree in their respective specialization.

7. Online and Document Submission

Applicants must complete two steps:

Step 1: Online Application

Register via the VNU admission portal: <http://admissions-apply.vnu.edu.vn>

Step 2: Submission of Application Documents

Applicants must submit **one complete set of documents (A4 size)**.

Documents in languages other than **English or Vietnamese** must be accompanied by notarized translations.

Required documents

1. Completed application form
2. Notarized copies of degrees, diplomas, and academic transcripts
3. Medical certificate issued within the last **six months** confirming fitness for overseas study

4. Certified language proficiency certificates
5. Proof of financial support
6. Documents demonstrating academic achievements or research experience (if applicable)
7. Copy of passport valid for the **expected duration of study or at least one year from the date of arrival**

Submitted documents will not be returned.
